Paris Internationale 2020 changes format to take form of an exhibition an exhibition in a vacant superette located at 12 rue de Montyon, in the centre of Paris. The exhibition is curated bt Claire Le Restif.

Claire Le Restif is and Art Historian. Since 2003, she is the Curator and Director of the Centre d'art contemporain d'Ivry - le Crédac. She chose to name the exhbition *SuperSalon* to evoke both the spirit of the 19th century Parisian art salons and the corner superette. *SuperSalon* proposes a curatorial vision true to the spirit of the inaugural edition of Paris Internationale.

Since 2015, Paris Internationale was conceived as an innovative alternative to traditional art fairs and a platform supporting forward-thinking projects. Our responsability to our exhibitors; our audience and our supporters, demands we embrace the many complexities of our present moment and meet these new challenges collaboratively and dynamically. Our exhibitors are required to be present in person. Solidarity being a core value in what we do, those who can join physically will represent those who cannot.

To provide those whose cannot be present with an opportunity to share the expe-







rience of this new edition, *SuperSalon* will be documented online and augmented with *viewings rooms* where galleries will present additional artworks and ample contextual material offering an additional window into the practices of the artists they work with. We hope that the same curiosity that drives visitors to Paris Internationale each year will be enhanced and rewarded by our online platform.

- Paris Internationale 2020 will be open to the public from Octobre 22-29, and by invitation only on Octobrer 20-21.
- Paris Internationale online will be accessible from October 20-29, and by invitation only on October 18-19.

This 6th edition will welcome 26 galleries hailing from 14 countries and 3 non-profit spaces.

## PHILOSOPHY

Paris Internationale is a non-profit initiative engaged for the Parisian and International artistic scenes.

Founded three years ago, Paris Internationale is a contemporary art fair for a younger generation of galleries encouraging the work of emerging artists. It was rapidly confirmed as a staple of the contemporary art month in October in Paris.

Collegial and associative, Paris Internationale was born out of a will to take control of its own future and to propose an exclusive event in Paris. Far from the rigid organization of more classical fairs, Paris Internationale operates on a small committee. Its structure is dynamic and reactive, allowing for a maximal liberty.

The philosophy of Paris Internationale is articulated around three principles:

- To propose affordable spaces and therefore encourage the exhibitors to present audacious projects.
- To attract the most interesting protagonists of a younger generation of galleries in Paris.
- To deconstruct the traditional codes of art fairs by anchoring the project in an outstanding context within Paris' city center

Organized by a quintet of emerging galleries, this pop-up fair near the Arc de Triomphe has quickly gained traction as the week's « discovery » event of choice for art-world insiders.
