Press Release

Paris Internationale is pleased to announce that its 7th edition will take place from 20 to 24 October 2021 at 186 avenue Victor Hugo in the heart of Paris, with 36 international galleries hailing from 21 countries.

Paris Internationale was founded in 2015 as an innovative alternative to traditional art fairs and rapidly developed into a vital instrument for promoting the work of emerging artists and for rediscovering more established figures. Forward thinking and collaborative, free spirited and audacious, the non-profit fair is gallery-initiated and aims to offer a rich selection of cutting-edge artistic projects presented by galleries from around the world.

While last year Paris Internationale took the form of a curated exhibition in a vacant supermarket in the center of Paris, this year's edition will mark a return to the fair's original format, in an ornate, high-ceilinged residential building dating back to the 19th century, true to the spirit of previous editions. As they progress through this intimate and welcoming setting, visitors will encounter a variety of experimental artistic projects. A gathering place to exchange ideas, Paris Internationale is further developing its support of a young generation of galleries and artists.

On the occasion of its seventh edition, Paris Internationale invited 36 galleries coming from 21 countries. Alongside the founding galleries, Ciaccia Levi (Paris), Crèvecoeur (Paris) and Gregor Staiger (Zurich), greengrassi (London), Kendall Koppe (Glasgow), KOW (Berlin), Misako & Rosen (Tokyo), Stereo (Warsaw), Veda (Florence) have been participating since the early editions and form the core of our community.

Amongst almost 20 new exhibitors, Paris Internationale is happy to welcome: Artbeat (Tbilisi), Crisis (Lima), Delgosha (Tehran), Ginsberg Galeria (Lima), Good Weather (North Little Rock/Chicago), Grey Noise (Dubai), Hot Wheels (Athens), Iragui (Moscow), LC Queisser (Tbilisi), Piedras (Buenos Aires), von ammon co (Washington DC).

For the first time, Paris Internationale is welcoming three participants from Africa: First Floor Gallery (Harare), Rhizome (Alger) et Selebe Yoon (Dakar).

cornerstone of the city's cultural agenda, Paris Art Week brings each October an unparalleled energy to the great galleries and cultural institutions of Paris, making the city a worldwide capital of art. In a world slowly opening up, Paris Internationale looks forward to bringing together its exhibitors and participants to celebrate contemporary art and the community in which they stand united.

To extend the reach of the fair and allow those who cannot be present to nevertheless experience this new edition, Paris Internationale will also maintain a digital format this year on its website, in addition to the physical fair. Through new functionalities allowing the exhibitors to present more artworks and ample contextual material, the digital edition will be an additional window into the practices of the artists featured at the fair.

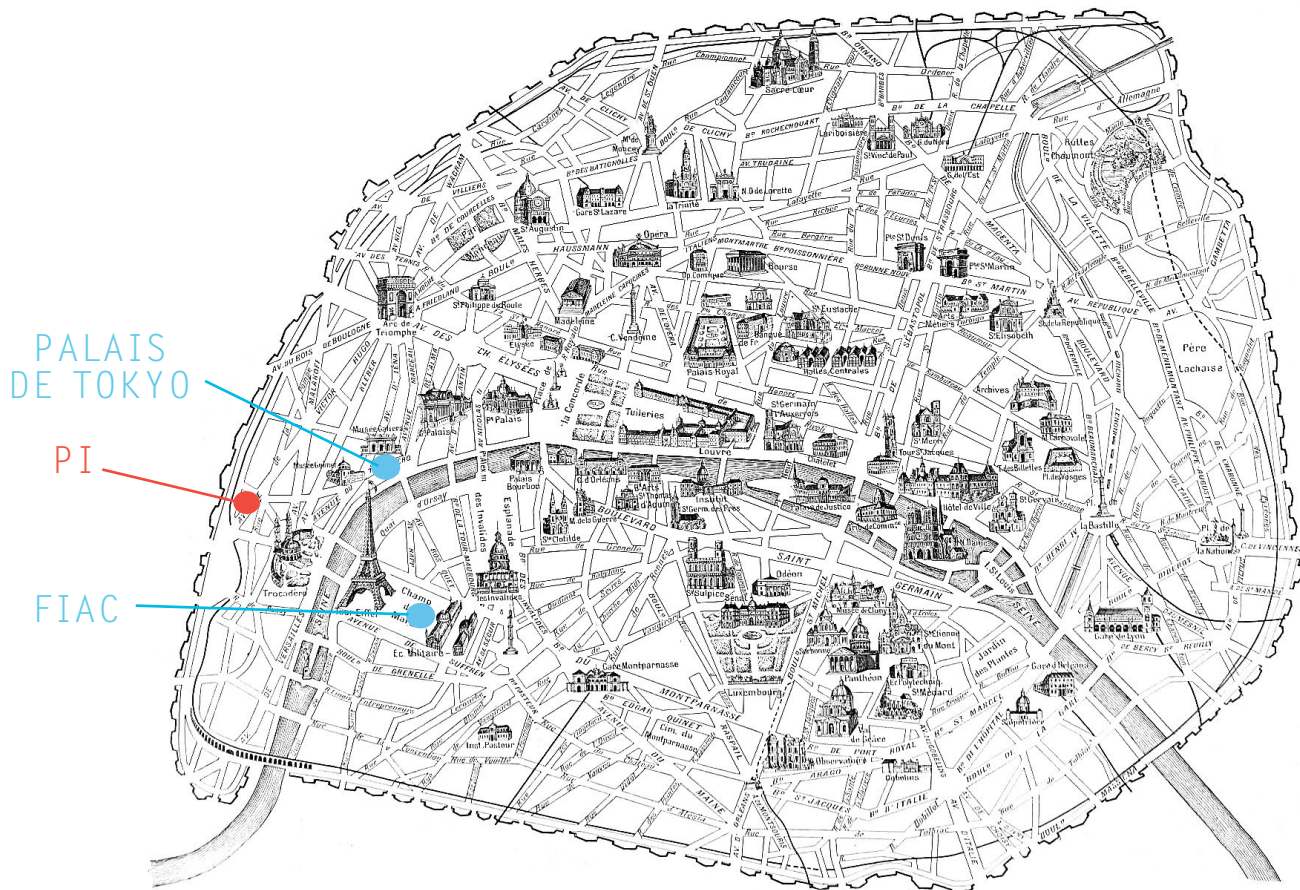
